
Installing OneDrive

If you do not already have OneDrive setup on your iPhone, you can install it from the AppStore.


1. Tap **App Store** from the applications screen
2. Search for *OneDrive*
3. Install the *Microsoft OneDrive* application, then tap **OneDrive** from the applications screen
4. Sign In using your Passport York e-mail address (username@yorku.ca)

Recording the Class

1. Tap **Voice Memo** from the applications screen
2. Tap the red circle to begin recording
3. Tap the red square to end recording




4. Tap **Done**
5. Name the file and tap **Save**
6. Tap on the recording you just made



7. Tap the **Share**  button

8. Tap **Copy to OneDrive**

9. Tap **Upload to OneDrive**

Installing OneDrive and Recording Software

5. Tap **Google Play Store** from the applications screen
6. Search for *OneDrive*
7. Install the *Microsoft OneDrive* application, then tap **OneDrive** from the applications screen
8. Sign In using your Passport York e-mail address (username@yorku.ca)
9. Perform the same steps above to install **Good MP3 recorder**


Recording the Class

10. Tap **Good MP3 recorder Memo** from the applications screen
11. Tap the **RECORDING** tab
12. Tap the *Triangle* button to begin recording
13. Tap the *Circle* button to end recording
14. Tap the **PLAYING** tab
15. Tap on the recording you just made, then tap **Share**
16. Select **OneDrive**
17. Tap the *Checkmark*


Uploading the Lecture to eClass via Panopto

It is recommended to upload the lecture to eClass via Panopto.

1. Sign into [OneDrive](#) using your Passport York credentials (username@yorku.ca)
2. Download the recording you want to upload to Panopto
3. Sign into [Panopto](#) using your Passport York credentials
4. Click **Browse** on the left side, then expand **Private** twice
5. Select the course to which you would like to upload the recordings



1. Click **Create then **Upload Media****



2. Drag the file to the upload box, the file will upload automatically
